PORTSMOUTH, Ohio - The trip from Richmond, Ind., proved to be a profitable for Duane Chamberlin.  
He jump to the point from the outside pole and never gave up the lead Saturday, June 10, in winning the Late Model A-Main at Portsmouth Raceway Park on Pepsi Employee Night.

On lap 5, he took third,  
A lap later, Adkins was trying to get under Miles Cook for second in turn 4. However, leader Bo Cox also went high, allowing Adkins to grab first.  
Less than one-half lap later, a five-car pile up took out the five cars directing behind Adkins.  
David Williams, who was running seventh, moved up to second. He stayed in contact with Adkins, but was could not get around.  
John Melvin was a repeat winner in the limited late. He started on the front row and quickly opened up a comfortable lead over Roger Pertuset and Evyian Terry.  
For the second straight week, the bomber A-Main was a battle until the checkered flag.  
Once again, Jeremie Bretz held off Darren Pendleton and Shane Pendeton to take the win.  
The trio stayed within a few car lengths over the final 11 laps.  
Starting on the front tow, Bretz grabbed the lead with the Pendleton Cousins in hot pursuit.  
Twice, Darren Pendleton was able to get under Bretz, but he could get no further than just in front of Bretz's rear tire.  
When Darren Pendleton was not trying to get by Bretz, he was fighting off Shane Pendleton. Shane Pendleton got beside Darren Pendleton on two occasions. They made contact, but Darren Pendleton held on.
