

# **Raceivers Now Mandatory at PRP**

In an effort to make racing safer and speed up restarts, Portsmouth Raceway Park will make Raceivers mandatory in 2009. Raceivers are one-way communication devices that allow drivers to hear vital information from track officials through earpieces they are able to wear underneath their helmets.

This technology allows for drivers to clearly be told where they need to fall in line prior to a restart, and raceivers can also be used to quickly tell the racers that a caution is out.

Considering these radios can prevent injury, torn up equipment, and wasted laps ran under caution, they undoubtedly are a great investment.

For drivers who already own a raceiver, be sure and bring it to the track where you will be notified of what frequency to turn to. For those who don't own a receiver, never fear. They can be purchased from PRP or at the RGM Parts truck that will be on hand in the pits.
